## What is that to you?- lesson on focus

Joh 21:18-22 Verily, verily, I say unto thee, When thou wast young, thou girdedst thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldest: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry thee whither thou wouldest not. 19 This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me. 20 Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee? 21 Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? 22 Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

## What is that to you about other's blessings?

1Co 12:25-26 That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another. 26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.....Ro 12:15 Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.

De 29:5 And I have led you forty years in the wilderness: your clothes are not waxen old upon you, and thy shoe is not waxen old upon thy foot. ....Nu 11:4-6 And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat? 5 We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely; the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlick: 6 But now our soul is dried away: there is nothing at all, beside this manna, before our eyes.

2Sa 11:2 And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman was very beautiful to look upon. 3 And David sent and enquired after the woman. And one said, Is not this Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?.... 2Sa 12:7-8 And Nathan said to David, Thou art the man. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul; 8 And I gave thee thy master's house, and thy master's wives into thy bosom, and gave thee the house of Israel and of Judah; and if that had been too little, I would moreover have given unto thee such and such things.

Ps 68:19 Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.

**Ps 50:10-12** For every beast of the forest is <u>mine</u>, and the cattle upon a thousand hills.11 I know all the fowls of the mountains: and the wild beasts of the field are <u>mine</u>. 12 If I were hungry, I would not tell thee: for the world is <u>mine</u>, and the fulness thereof.

**1Co 4:1-2** Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and <u>stewards</u> of the mysteries of God. 2 <u>Moreover it</u> <u>is required in stewards</u>, that a man be found faithful.

**Lu 12:48** But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto **whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required**: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

## What is that to you about what others are doing?

**1Sa 8:4-7** Then all the elders of Israel gathered themselves together, and came to Samuel unto Ramah, 5 And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: <u>now make us a king to judge us like all the nations</u>. 6 But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD. 7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.... **1Sa 8:18-20** <u>And ye shall cry out in that day because of your king which ye shall have chosen you</u>; and the LORD will not hear you in that day. 19 Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us; 20 <u>That we also may be like all the nations</u>; and that our king may judge us, and go out before us, and fight our battles.

Mt 7:13-14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

**Eph 5:3-4** But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, <u>as becometh</u> saints; 4 Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

2Ti 2:3-4 Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. 4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

**Ga 6:7-8** Be not deceived; God is not mocked: <u>for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap</u>. 8 For he that <u>soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption</u>; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

Pr 23:29-30 Who hath <u>woe</u>? who hath <u>sorrow</u>? who hath <u>contentions</u>? who hath <u>babbling</u>? who hath <u>wounds without</u> cause? who hath redness of eyes? 30 They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine.

Pr 6:26-28 For by means of a whorish woman a man is brought to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life. 27 Can a man take fire in his bosom, and his clothes not be burned? 28 Can one go upon hot coals, and his feet not be burned?

1Jo 2:15-17 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

## What is that to you when it comes to...

Fear from men- Ac 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.

Mt 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Thief on cross- Mr 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Ac 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, <u>Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins</u>, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
