Why worship God and is He worthy of our worship?

Re 4:11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

The equation to giving God what He wants

Joh 4:21-24 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. 22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. 23 But the hour cometh, and now is, <u>when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth:</u> for the Father seeketh such to worship him. 24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must <u>worship him in spirit</u> and in truth.

Mt 15:7-9 Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, 8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me. 9 But <u>in vain they do worship me</u>, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

Ac 17:23 For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore **ye ignorantly worship**, him declare I unto you.

Worship is not just being here

Mal 1:6-7 A son honoureth his father, and a servant his master: if then I be a father, where is mine honour? and if I be a master, where is my fear? saith the LORD of hosts unto you, O priests, that despise my name. And ye say, Wherein have we despised thy name? 7 Ye offer polluted bread upon mine altar; and ye say, Wherein have we polluted thee? In that ye say, The table of the LORD is contemptible.

Joh 4:23-24 But the hour cometh, and now is, <u>when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in</u> <u>truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.</u> 24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must <u>worship him in</u> <u>spirit and in truth</u>.

Ro 1:9 For God is my witness, whom <u>I serve with my spirit</u> in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers;

Ro 7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. <u>So then with the **mind** I myself serve the law of God</u>; but with the flesh the law of sin.

1Co 14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.

1Co 11:29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

Worship is not giving God the leftovers

Mal 1:8-9 And if <u>ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil</u>? and if <u>ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil</u>? <u>offer it now</u> <u>unto thy governor</u>; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts. 9 And now, I pray you, beseech God that he will be gracious unto us: this hath been by your means: will he regard your persons? saith the LORD of hosts.

Le 1:1-3 And the LORD called unto Moses, and spake unto him out of the tabernacle of the congregation, saying, 2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, If any man of you bring an offering unto the LORD, ye shall bring your offering of the cattle, even of the herd, and of the flock. 3 If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male <u>without blemish</u>: he shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD.

1Co 16:2 Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

Lu 21:1-4 And he looked up, and saw the rich men casting their gifts into the treasury. 2 And he saw also <u>a certain poor</u> <u>widow casting in thither two mites</u>. 3 And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, <u>that this poor widow hath cast in more</u> <u>than they all</u>: 4 For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: <u>but she of her penury hath cast</u> <u>in all the living that she had</u>.

2Co 8:12 For if there be first a willing mind, it is accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not.

2Co 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

Worship is not an obligation

Mal 1:13 Ye said also, <u>Behold, what a weariness is it! and ye have snuffed at it</u>, saith the LORD of hosts; and ye brought that which was torn, and the lame, and the sick; thus ye brought an offering: <u>should I accept this of your hand</u>? saith the LORD.

Re 2:23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

Mal 1:10 Who is there even among you that would shut the doors for nought? neither do ye kindle fire on mine altar for nought. I have no pleasure in you, saith the LORD of hosts, neither will I accept an offering at your hand.
